



PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy explains how Malta Classic collects, uses, shares or otherwise processes personal information that is provided to us by our members, clients and interested parties who use our website and buy our products, or that Malta Classic may otherwise obtain or generate, which relates to such persons.

SECTION 1 – WHAT DO WE DO WITH YOUR INFORMATION?

Malta Classic takes your privacy seriously and will only use your personal information to provide the products and services you request from us.

When you visit our website and complete any of our booking forms or purchase any tickets or merchandise online, we may collect the personal information you give us such as your name, surname, email address, ID card number or other personal identification document number, date of birth, residential address, contact number, hotel you may be staying at while visiting our event whether as a participant or a spectator, and dates of your stay, amongst other information. We gather and generate information about you when you provide it to us or interact with us directly or through our ticket master.

We may also receive professional and other information about you from other sources, including publicly available sources. We may combine information that we have about you from various sources, including the information that you have provided us with.

We may process and use your personal information to:

- *With your consent:* We will at times ask for your specific consent to process your personal information, such as when you fill in our booking forms.
- *For the performance of a contract/obligation:* If you purchase any tickets or merchandise, we will process your data insofar as it is necessary for the performance of our obligations towards you.
- *For compliance with a legal obligation:* We may at times be legally obliged to process your personal information in order to comply with demands or requests made by local and foreign regulators, governments, courts and law enforcement authorities, or with a court process, or in connection with any litigation, or in order to comply with our legal obligations.
- *For legitimate business purposes:* We may at times use your personal information for our legitimate business purposes. Where we use your personal information for this purpose, rest assured that we will take measures to protect your personal information.

The above shall be the basis for processing your personal data.

SECTION 3 – DISCLOSURE

Your personal information will be received by Malta Classic’s representatives. We may also share your personal information with any of the following:

- Our third party agents, service providers and suppliers strictly as required in order to carry out the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy;
- Our professional advisors, strictly for consultation purposes or for the compliance with our legal obligations or in the course of the provision of our services;
- Regulators, government and law enforcement authorities as and when this is required under applicable laws and regulations;
- Courts, tribunals, arbitrators or other competent bodies who may have authority to request such personal information.

SECTION 4 – THIRD-PARTY SERVICES

The third-party providers used by Malta Classic will only collect, use and disclose your information to the extent necessary to allow them to perform the services they provide us with.

Once you leave our website or are redirected to a third-party website or application, you are no longer covered by this Privacy Policy or our Disclaimer.

When you click on links on our website, they may direct you away from our site. We are not responsible for the privacy practices of other sites and encourage you to read their privacy policies too.

All payments effected on our website take place directly via a third party processor which stores your credit card data. While Malta Classic endeavours to use safe and secure systems,

we do not at any point handle your payment information. Further information regarding the payment method and security features in place may be requested from the third party processor.

SECTION 5 – SECURITY

To protect your personal information, we take reasonable precautions and follow industry best practices to make sure it is not inappropriately lost, misused, accessed, disclosed, altered or destroyed. To this end we have implemented security policies, rules and technical measures to protect the personal data that we have under our control. All our data processors who have access to and are associated with the processing of personal data, are further obliged to respect the confidentiality of our clients' personal data.

By its very nature however the Internet is not a secure medium and data sent via this medium can potentially be subject to unauthorised acts by third parties. We cannot guarantee the privacy or confidentiality of any information passing over our website.

Moreover, data sent via the Internet may be transmitted across international borders even where sender and receiver of information are located in the same country. Consequently, data relating to you may be transmitted via a country having a lower level of data protection than that existing in your country of residence. We shall accept no responsibility or liability whatsoever for the security of your data while in transit through the Internet.

SECTION 6 – COOKIES

When you browse our website, we also automatically receive your computer's internet protocol (IP) address in order to provide us with information that helps us learn about your browser and operating system.

By continuing to use our website and consenting to the use of cookies, you agree to us placing cookies on your device and accessing them when you visit the website in the future. If you want to delete any cookies that are already on your computer, the "help" section in your browser should provide instructions on how to locate the file or directory that stores cookies. Please note that by deleting or disabling future cookies, your user experience of this website may be affected and you might not be able to take advantage of certain functions of our website.

The information so gathered through cookies may include but not be limited to the date and time when you access our website; the website pages that you view and any download that you may make through such pages; whether or not such viewing or download is successful; the Internet address of the website or the domain name of the computer from which you access our website and the operating system of the machine running your web browser; and the type and version of your web browser.

SECTION 7 – AGE OF CONSENT

By using this website, you represent that you are at least the age of majority in your state, county, province, region or country of residence, or that you are the age of majority in your

state, county, province, region or country of residence and you have given us your consent to allow any of your minor dependents to use this website.

SECTION 8 – DATA RETENTION

As a general rule, we keep your personal information for as long as we need to in order to carry out those purposes for which your data has been collected. In the event that you deem that your information is being unnecessarily retained, you may wish to contact us and Malta Classic will delete all your personal information.

SECTION 9 – YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to:

- Ask Malta Classic about the processing of your personal information, including to be provided with a copy of your personal information held by Malta Classic;
- to request the correction and/or deletion of your personal information, or restrict or object to the processing of your personal information;

If you object to our processing of your personal information, we will respect your request in accordance with our legal obligations. Your objection may mean that we may not be able to perform the actions necessary to provide you with the requested service.

If after you opt in to receiving updates by email, you change your mind, you may withdraw your consent by contacting us on secretary@maltaclassic.com. Kindly note that this will not affect the legality of any processing previously undertaken with your consent.

Malta Classic may be required or entitled to retain your information to comply with legal and regulatory obligations and to protect and exercise its legal rights and legitimate interests.
